

## TIME-21 Transportation Tour

### Transportation Committee Hearings

February 21-22 and 28-29, 2008

In December 2006, the Iowa Legislature passed a law that established the TIME-21 Fund which addresses the dramatic need to improve the condition of Iowa's bridges, highways, roads, railway systems and structures. The TIME-21 Initiative calls for the State Legislature to fund up to \$200 Million annually to invest in state roads and highways. *Unfortunately, no funds were appropriated.*

Iowa State Senators, Tom Rielly and Larry Noble, have arranged a "TIME-21 Transportation Tour" to several Iowa communities in order to gauge support from local constituency for funding of the TIME-21 Initiative. During the TIME-21 Transportation Tour, ten Iowa cities will host "Transportation Committee Hearings" where State Senators Rielly and Noble will answer questions and listen to opinions and concerns regarding TIME-21 issues.

Transportation is a major concern for the State of Iowa, and economic development is unavoidably tied to Iowa's transportation network. Improvements to this network are imperative if the state is to effectively compete for good jobs and economic growth.

We encourage you to take this opportunity and attend at least one of the "Committee Hearings" listed on the Transportation Tour and to express your opinions regarding TIME-21. CRDC supports TIME-21, and we hope that you, too, will make every effort to impress upon the Iowa Legislature the importance of funding this very important initiative.
