Illinois Clinton Region

| Tax Type | |
|---|--|
| Sales | 5% Local/ 1.25 to 1.5% Local |
| Gasoline (Gallon) | \$0.19 |
| Diesel | \$0.215 |
| Electricity | Sales tax is based on kilowatt hours used. Rates are \$.00330 declining to \$.00202; large users can opt to self assess tax at 5.1% of cost; Cities are eligible to impose a Municipal Tax |
| Natural Gas | State is lower of 5.1% or \$0.024/therm; In addition municipalities may impose a municipal tax |
| Telecommunications | State Telecommunications Excise Tax is 7% all services that originate or terminate in Illinois & are billed in Illinois; State Additional Charge of .1% applies for revenue derived from calls and services within Illinois; State Infrastructure Maintenance Fee of .5% applies to gross charges; Municipalities can charge their own taxes |
| Property per \$1,000 of market value (IL Average) | 5% Local/ 1.25 to 1.5% Local |
